**Known reprints in early issues of English Mechanic**

Note, this is not a full list of differences between originals and reprints, but only sufficient to recognize between them.

No. 1	March , 31 , 1865	The reprint differs only on page 12, with an advert for the "English Mechanic" offering a monthly part, which was not made available until 26th April.	
No. 2	April , 07 , 1865	The reprint on page 20, has an extra 3 line article about the Sculptor, Carl Kiss, and the adverts on pages 23 and 24 differ, including one for "English Mechanic" offering a monthly part.	
No. 15	July , 07, 1865	page 174 different... the reprint has articles titled "Gullet's improved auger", and "Improved hollow auger", neither of which are in the index. The original has in its place an article titled "Raising vessels in sheet metal" which is in the index.	
No. 31	October , 27, 1865	The reprint has missing page numbers and the publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page, the original says incorrectly issue No. 30.	57 to 60
No. 32	November , 03, 1865	The reprint has the publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page, the original is missing the issue number, being hand written, in examples seen.	
No. 33	November , 10, 1865	The reprint has the publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page	
No. 37	December , 08, 1865	On page 125 the original has letters, including one titled "cheap telescopes", the reprint these are replaced by an article titled "Prale's wood-planing machinery"	
No. 41	January , 05, 1866	missing page numbers or "REPRINT" printed on first page, and publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page	177 to 184
No. 42	January , 12, 1866	missing page numbers or "REPRINT" printed on first page, and publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page	201 to 204
No. 43	January , 19, 1866	missing page numbers or "REPRINT" printed on first page, and publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page	217 to 224
No. 44	January , 26, 1866	missing page numbers or "REPRINT" printed on first page, and publishers address listed as "2 Shoe Lane" on last page	243 and 244

In issue No. 4, it is announced that "So large has the demand been for the publication, that the first and second numbers are now being reprinted" and earlier in the same issue "The First Monthly Part of the ENGLISH MECHANIC will be published on the 26th of this month, containing 60 Pages, in coloured wrapper. Price 6d. Only!"

In issue No. 66, it is announced that The English Mechanic has removed from 75 Fleet Street to premises at 2 and 3 Shoe Lane. So any issue giving this address was printed after June 1866.

In issue No. 80, October, 5, 1866 it is announced that issues numbered 31,42,43 and 44 have been reprinted.

In issue No. 84, November, 2, 1866 it is announced that issues numbered 31,32,33,41,42,43 and 44 have been reprinted.
